Message from FOLTC President Suzanne Carter

As you read this edition of our newsletter, you will agree that the Friends are very busy at this time of year. The funds generated from these book & bake sales go a long way toward meeting our goal of raising a minimum of \$5,000 in 2019 so the libraries can benefit from the County Commissioner's Matching Challenge Grant. If FOLTC raises \$5,000, then the County will provide an additional \$5,000 to our libraries. These \$10,000 in funding are used by library staff to purchase library materials such as adult and children's books, magazines, newspapers, audiobooks, DVDs, and other needed items for both libraries.

You, as a Friend of the Libraries of Towns County, can do your part by remaining a Friend and renewing your yearly membership, volunteering with the FOLTC by donating books, helping set up for book sales, baking goods for the bake sales, and many other fun opportunities.

Our public libraries depend on the income generated by the Friends, and the Friends depend on you, our members!


