
#### PRESIDENT WELKEN'S MESSAGE

### HAPPENINGS AT YOUR LIBRARY

This fall has been a busy couple of months for us here at TCPL. We have brought back Bingo on Friday at 2:00 pm once a month with prizes coming from the FOLTC bookstore! Please check with our staff for complete details. We also started a new children's program, Crafternoon, where kids can come in and make a craft every Wednesday at 3:30! So far it has developed into a rather consistent group, and we continue to see new faces as well!

As many of you know already, we had planned to have a large Fall Festival on the square in September, but due to unprecedented weather conditions we elected to cancel the event. We did, however, take many of the things we had planned and rolled them into our Halloween Carnival at the library! The carnival was a wonderful success with nearly a tripling of attendance from last year's event! We gave away over 40 books which were purchased using FOLTC funding to the children! Also in October we staffed a booth at the Fairground's trick or treat event. Along with library staff and a few FOLTC volunteers, we gave out coupons for free books to the first 200 children to trick or treat with us and candy and popcorn to 4,000 trick or treaters and their families.







With October coming to a close and the holiday season looming, we have begun to look toward Thanksgiving and Christmas. We have launched a Baking Competition Take and Make for November with funding provided by FOLTC. During this program, patrons will be able to stop by the library and get a baking kit while supplies last. Patrons can bake whatever they would like (with or without a kit) as long as it is Thanksgiving themed. Pictures of the completed baked goods are due by Nov. 27<sup>th</sup>, and we will post them as a Facebook vote. Later this season, FOLTC is going to be integral in supporting our Cookies with the Grinch event in December where we hope to get books in the hands of children in time for the holiday break.

## PEACH STATE FCU AWARDS \$1,500 GRANT TO TOWNS COUNTY LIBRARIES

Friends of the Libraries of Towns County (FOLTC) is the proud recipient of a \$1,500 grant from Peach State Federal Credit Union to be issued over a three-year period. It will be shared equally between Mountain Regional Library and Towns County Public Library. The previous grant (\$500 per year from 2019-2023) was used to provide supplemental funding for the annual children's summer reading programs and for other programs offered to children and adults in Towns County. This current grant will be used for similar activities for our communities.

Peach State FCU cares about the people in their communities and contributes funds in support of education and other opportunities that promote learning. FOLTC is fortunate to benefit from PSFCU's foundation, which in turn allows the Friends to provide support for our libraries and the children and adults in our communities.


