FOLTC SUPPORTS FERST READERS IN TOWNS COUNTY

Ferst Readers of Towns County is a local organization whose goal is to provide free high quality and age and developmentally appropriate books to all children in the county who are under the age of five and are registered with Ferst Readers. Their vision is "create better learners, brighter futures, and stronger communities by giving every child under five access to quality books in their homes." Ferst Readers is available in more than 100 counties and communities in ten states, including Georgia and Towns County.

Children can be registered at the Towns County Library, Mountain Regional Library, Towns County Health Department, County Elementary School, online at www.ferstreaders.org, or by phone at 888-565-0177. Books are mailed monthly to each registered child. Please consider registering your children who are under the age of five so they can begin to grow their home library and become successful readers.

and promote literacy for young children in our communities. FOLTC members realize that children who have books in their homes and are read to at home are more successful in school.
