



FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARIES ANNOUNCE SCHOLARSHIP

The Friends of the Libraries of Towns County (FOLTC) announce their first scholarship to be awarded to a graduating senior of Towns County High School who will pursue post-secondary education at a 4-year college, 2-year school, or technical school. The award is a one-time, \$1,000 scholarship to be set annually and must be used for education-related expenses such as tuition, books, living and/or travel expenses related to their program, etc.

The scholarship was established to assist a deserving student in realizing their educational goals and dreams. Requirements include: a completed application form, two essays addressing (1) how reading and libraries have impacted the student's life and (2) how this scholarship will impact the student's ability to further their education, and two letters of recommendation as stipulated on the application.

Deadline for applications is **Thursday, April 2, 2026**, by the end of the school day.
