I attended a Young Harris town hall meeting in February and was approached by Scott Roland and Jennifer Marshall from the Peach State Federal Credit Union, which has a branch office in Young Harris. Scott told me that they were interested in making a contribution to our Friends group, as supporting local educational endeavors in their communities is part of their mission. We completed the necessary paperwork for the PSFCU and recently met for the check presentation at Mountain Regional Library (see photo below). The Credit Union has committed to making a \$500 donation to the FOLTC for the next 5 years (for a total of \$2,500). The funds will be shared equally by both of our libraries. We are thrilled that this business understands the importance of public libraries in their communities.

In April, the FOLTC Board approved a motion by the bookstore committee to hire Bart Williams of Williams Electric to make improvements to the book storage area where all of the donated books are kept until placed in the bookstore. Electricity, LED lights, a ceiling fan, plus an AC unit with dehumidifier were installed. Now we can work and store books in an area that is well lit and dry. Bart is professional and congenial, and we thank him for doing an excellent job!

Waiting to Hear:



- Circulated over 77,000 items.


