All monies generated by FOLTC fundraising projects go to Mountain Regional Library and Towns County Public Library to purchase books and other library materials, to help fund children's reading programs, and to meet other needs of the libraries.

FOLTC is having a Thanksgiving Pie/Sourdough Bread Fundraiser again this year, partnering with Mercier Orchards for apple, pumpkin, and pecan pies to be available for your Thanksgiving celebrations. Board member Darlene Pilcher will bake mini-loaves of her tasty sourdough bread to go with your holiday dinner.

Only 150 pies and 75 loaves of sourdough bread are available; many have already been sold. Pre-order and pay for yours by Tuesday, November 12th or before they are all sold. Select either Mountain Regional Library or Towns County Public Library for pickup. Pickup date will be Tuesday, November 26th, between 11:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. at your specified library.

The 2018 Thanksgiving Pie Sale generated \$1,160 for our libraries. You made it successful, and we anticipate this year's sale will be more successful. FOLTC is very grateful to everyone who supports our fundraisers and the libraries of Towns County.

THANKSGIVING IDEA

An FOLTC friend encourages you to try this recipe during the holidays. Of course she suggests using the sourdough bread from the Thanksgiving Pie/Sourdough Bread Sale!

Mushroom Toasts with Fried Sage

*Using the mini-loaves of sourdough bread makes 12 appetizer size toasts.

Ingredients: 2 tbsp. unsalted butter, 2 tbsp. olive oil, 12 fresh sage leaves, 1 lb. mixed mushrooms, thinly sliced, 1 clove garlic, finely chopped, 1/2 cup heavy cream, 8 tbsp. ricotta cheese, 4 thick slices sourdough bread, toasted*

In a large skillet over medium-high heat, melt butter in oil. Fry sage leaves until crisp, 20 to 30 seconds. Transfer to plate. Add mushrooms and garlic to skillet. Cook, stirring occasionally, until browned, 10 minutes; season. Add cream. Stir for 2 minutes; season. Spread ricotta on toasts. Top with mushrooms and sage leaves.
