COMMISSIONER'S CHALLENGE GRANT



On Wednesday, April 14th, the Commissioner's Matching Challenge Grant was presented to two representatives of the Towns County libraries: Jessica Tibbetts, Branch Manager - MRL and TCPL, and Heath Lee, MRLS Director. This annual grant of \$10,000 is a 50/50 partnership between the Friends of the Libraries and Towns County government.

This grant will help both libraries, MRL and TCPL, to purchase new library materials for children and adults. Libraries have taken many state-level funding cuts over the past years, so the Matching Challenge Grant was developed to help offset some of these cuts.

The Friends of the Libraries' portion of the grant comes from various fundraising activities, such as our book



FOLTC MISSION STATEMENT


