### **BAKE SALE RETURNS AFTER 4 YEARS!**

After four long years, the Friends decided to host a one-day bake sale at Mountain Regional Library on October 19<sup>th</sup>. It turned out to be a very successful endeavor, with a total of close to \$1,200 raised. These funds will be divided between Mountain Regional Library and Towns County Public Library. Library managers Ann Lewis (MRL) and Kevin Kirby (TCPL) will be able to request these funds from FOLTC to be used for such things as books and other library materials and adult and



children's programming. The mission of FOLTC is to support our libraries, and this is one of the ways FOLTC raises funds to accomplish this mission.



The bake sale would not have been possible without the efforts of FOLTC board members, members of the Friends, and others who volunteered to bake goodies and help with the sale. There was a total of 29 people who spent hours baking goodies such as cookies,

scones, cakes, pies, brownies, cobblers, muffins, breads, and other

delicious items. Thirteen people helped with setting up the sale and pricing the multitude of items, accepting payment, restocking the tables, and cleaning up after the sale. They all deserve many thanks for their tremendous efforts on behalf of our two libraries. Of course, thanks go to the many people who attended and purchased all of this delicious food. Shoppers were essential to this endeavor!
